# Interdisciplinary Myanmar Conference 2017

*16th – 18th June 2017*

For the past five years, Myanmar has seen political, economic and social change. Conflicts have flared, attempts at peace have been made, the government has changed and yet, established policies seem to remain. Civil society has new spaces, and freedom of speech is curtailed along new borders. Any attempt at describing the developments in Myanmar comprehensively is futile, so we won't attempt it here. Rather, we invite you to join us in sharing knowledge and expertise during this year's interdisciplinary Myanmar conference.

The **Interdisciplinary Myanmar Conference 2017** continues a tradition of former meetings, workshops, and conferences. The *Wissenschaftsforum Myanmar* (WiMya), founded 2012 in Passau, has merged with the newly founded *Myanmar-Institute*. It aims at facilitating exchange and networking between the small, but growing research community interested in Myanmar in German speaking Europe, and facilitating linkage with international and Myanmar Researchers. After several conferences, held since 2012 in Passau, Halle, Zürich and Berlin, this year's conference takes a first step in said direction.
